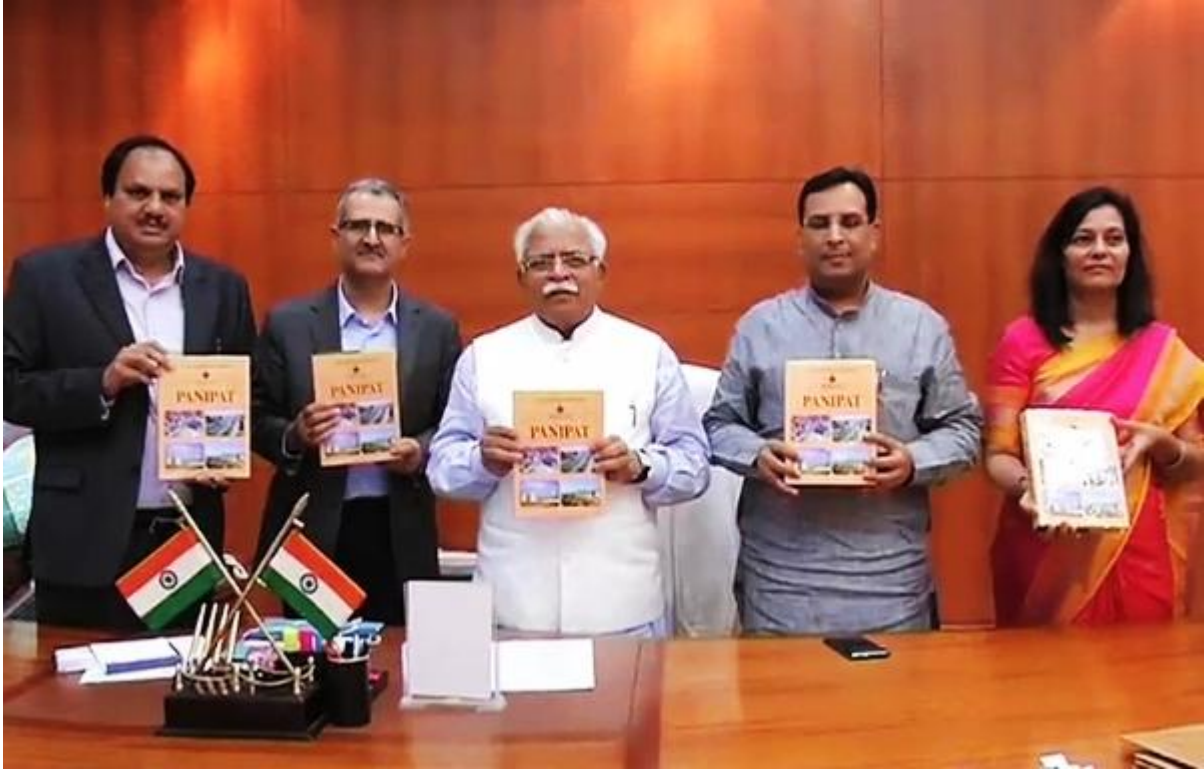


PANIPAT DISTRICT GAZETTEER RELEASED



Hon'ble Chief Minister Haryana Sh. Manohar Lal released the Panipat District Gazetteer on 16.11.2015 in his office at Haryana Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh.
